COUNSELING IN THE CLASSROOM

- Minute meetings: counselors meet briefly with every student in the building in the first two weeks of school
- Career Exploration lessons and assessments in all grade levels
- SOS Suicide Prevention Lesson in 7th grade
- High School Transition lessons in 8th
- Technology safety lessons in 6th and 7th grade.
- Personal Strength Exploration in 8th grade
- High School Specialty Program 8th grade
- Healthy Relationships 8th Grade
- Flirting or Hurting Sexual harassment prevention 7th grade.
- Academic and Career planning 6th 7th 8th

COUNSELING BY THE NUMBERS

- Personal: student problem, social issue, family issue, mood, wanted to talk through something. 760 meetings
- Academic Concern/Help 167 meetings
- Attendance Concern 70 meetings
