## 2023-2024 End of Year Results

- Language Arts had a pass rate of 79% (58%)
- Mathematics had a pass rate of 73% (52%)
- Science had a pass rate of 56% (49%)
- Social Studies 74%
- Chronic Absenteeism 24.7 to 17.5

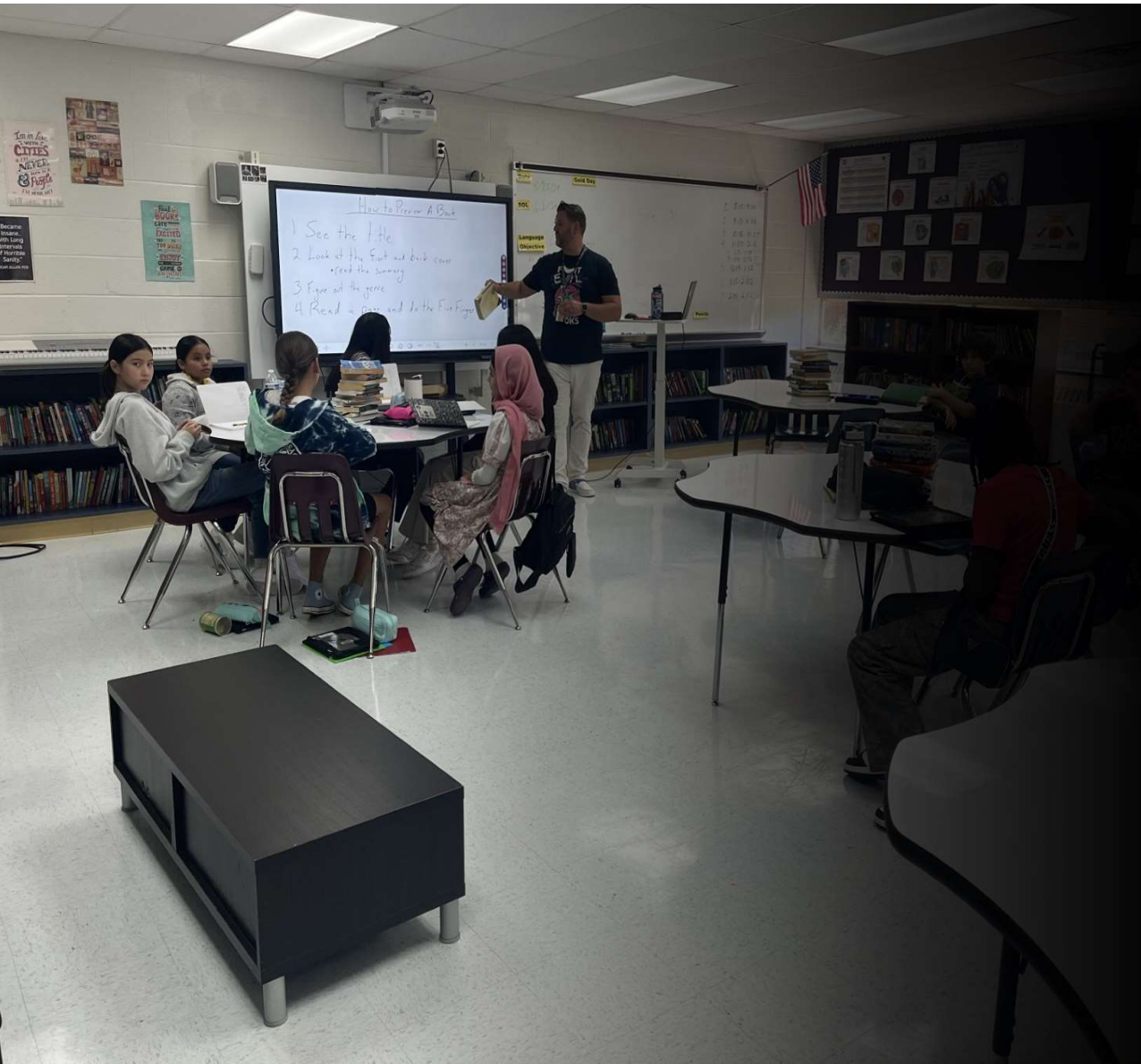
# Learning and Achievement for All

- Use the Building Thinking Classrooms Model to plan and instruct the lessons.
- Reflect on student performance to improve areas of low performance through reteaching and remediation.
- Use visual representations to help students master the content.



## Learning and Achievement for All

### Science

- How will we meet our 60% pass rate?

Teachers will...

- Use the 5E (Explore, Engage, Explain, Elaborate and Evaluate) instructional model during instruction.
- Reflect on student performance to improve areas of low performance through reteaching and remediation.
- Use exit tickets for students to demonstrate mastery of vocabulary and critical thinking.
